

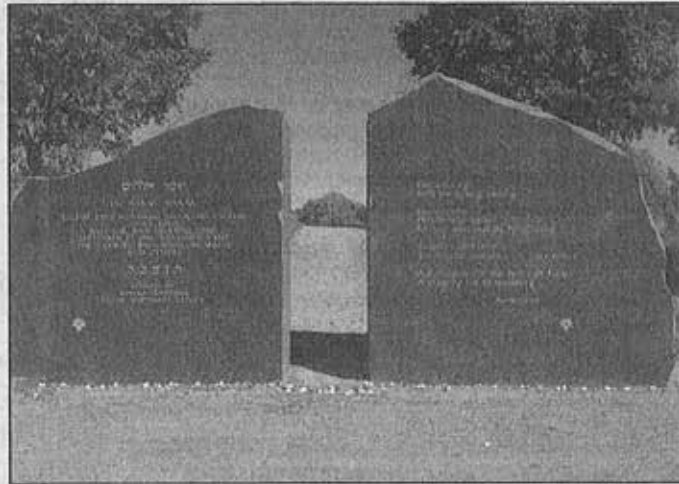

Memorial service planned at Babi Yar Park, Sunday, Sept. 28

In memory of the thousands of Jews, Ukrainians and others who were murdered from 1941-1943 at the Babi Yar ravine on the outskirts of Kiev, Ukraine, the Mizel Museum presents a memorial service Sunday, Sept. 28, 11 a.m.-noon, at Denver's Babi Yar Park.

Keynote speaker will be Julian Bonder, the architect selected with artist Krzysztof Wodiczko to create the Babi Yar Park memorial art project, dedicated to victims of world terrorism.

Bonder has recently returned from



a trip to Russia.
